

Teacher says, "This is a story. Touch the box for the first word. Get ready to slide to each dot and sound out the word. I will clap for each sound. Don't stop the sounds" "Get ready, sound it out." (clap for each letter. Hold on each letter for 2 seconds.) "Say it fast. " "yes, what word?" "Yes," "Back to the box." (repeat) "Touch the box for the next word. Get ready, sound it out" (clap for each sound). "Say it fast." "Yes, What word?" "Yes," "Back to the box." (repeat) (Continue with this process for each word in the passage. Repeat passage once.)
